In her movie SIGNING, Nurith Aviv ventures into the relatively uncharted territory of sign languages. Sign languages are numerous and diverse, each one with its own grammar and syntax, its unique richness and complexity.

Three generations of protagonists, deaf and hearing, as well as researchers from the Sign Language Research Laboratory at the University of Haifa, tell of the sign languages that have evolved in Israel within the past 100 years.

In this film, Nurith Aviv continues the discussion of issues close to her heart — mother tongue, translation, and intergenerational transmission. An invitation to broaden our perception of human languages.
